4. Print out the application and fill out the information.

All personal information will be highly guarded.

After the application is received it will be forwarded to the proper authority to be reviewed.

Please allow up to a month for us to respond to you after the application has been received.

Persons applying for gate clearance at state facilities including (Wende, Gowanda or Collins correctional) only

- 1. Proof of a TB inoculation is required
- 2. A photo ID picture and finger prints must be taken at the facilities
- 3. A 2-3 hour orientation program must be attended
