HOW DO I CLEAR THE GATE???

1. Go to buffaloaany.org on the web. (This is our Alcoholics Anonymous web site) 2. Click on the **FORMS** link at the bottom of the home page. 3. Click on the **ERIE COUNTY HOLDING CENTER VOLUNTEER CLEARANCE INFOMATION FORM Link** (if applying for a gate clearance at Erie county jail or holding center) or

Click on the **NY state corrections application for correction link** (If applying for a gate clearance at Wende, Gowanda or Collins correctional facilities)

4. Print out the application and fill out the information.

5. Mail the application
(Please include a phone number with the application so we can contact you after the application has been reviewed by prison staff.)
