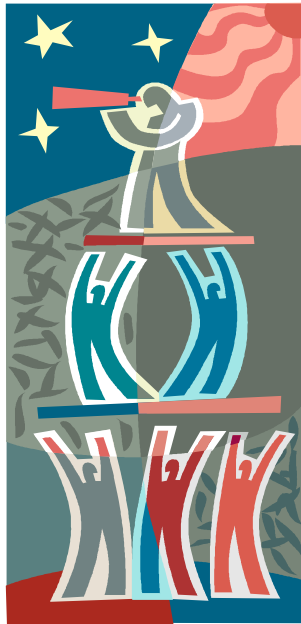

The purpose of this committee is to foster and encourage group participation in the Buffalo Area Central Committee and to provide training to facilitate participation.



What We Do

The Education & Participation committee is responsible for fostering and encouraging group participation at the Buffalo Area Intergroup. This is done by providing training to new Intergroup Representatives, putting on workshops for the fellowship about various A.A. related topics, and reaching out and educating groups about what the Intergroup does and why we need volunteers.



What types of service work can A.A. members do at the Education & Participation Committee?
