## Tuning in to Our Higher Power

I had heard the last half of the Eleventh Step many times in meetings: "... praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out," yet I often wondered just how one can learn about God's will.

One day during an Eleventh Step meeting someone spoke of "tuning in" to God's will through regular periods of prayer and meditation. A picture of the TV set at home flashed across my mind. I saw myself twisting the knob to change channels, and with this came a new approach (for me) to this part of the Eleventh Step.

When I want to pick up the picture from a television station, I don't start by asking the station engineer to tune the signal to the place on the dial where my TV is set. In-stead, I turn the knob at home to find the channel that carries that broadcast signal. In other words, I adjust to the station's setting instead of expecting it to comply with mine. Might not the same thing be true for the signals that come from my Higher Power?


Viewed this way the entire purpose of prayer and meditation becomes that of focusing on God's will for me instead of asking for this or that according to my will at the moment. Instead of expecting my Higher Power to change things to suit me (the equivalent of asking a TV station to move its signal to the channel where my dial is set), I need to focus my daily period of quiet meditation on creating a condition within myself that opens me up to, and accepts, God's will for me. The first step in seeking God's will is that of becoming receptive to it!

Since that day when the image of the TV set came to mind I've felt so much more in tune with the entire purpose of the Eleventh Step. The act of focusing on God's will--as we are told to do in the second part of the Step--increases my success with the first portion that deals with improving my conscious contact with God as I understand him.

The "Twelve and Twelve" tells us that when we catch a glimpse of God's will for us, and focus on the real and eternal things of life such as love and truth, we are no longer deeply disturbed by many smaller things that surround us in our daily affairs. Tuning in to a Higher Power truly leads to greater serenity--and to a much richer way of life!

## ENVELOPE SYSTEM? WHAT'S THAT???

The Envelope System was established to allow AA members to directly contribute monies to help defray the costs of operating the Buffalo Central Office, which in turn helps carry the message. By keeping the lines of AA open, through the Central Office, the hand of AA may be ever more accessible to the troubled alcoholic.

*Joining the Envelope System gives you an opportunity to put our 12<sup>th</sup> Step into action and allows you to say in one more way... I am responsible.*

There are many costs involved in keeping the Central Office open, such as telephones, postage, lights, rent, schedules, website up-keep, ECT.

*To become a member is quite simple. Just call Central Office, leave your name and address and let them know that you are interested. The Envelope Chairman will send you a form, you decide on how much and how often...and we are off and running. Now wasn't that easy! What is better is the feeling you get.*

*Now we even have the options of putting it on a credit/ debit card. You can even set up automatic payments through your bank account. (At least I have this option with my online bill pay)*

*Don't know how much to contribute? Maybe consider putting in what you drank a day, all right so that is a little silly, maybe. But why not at least the cost of a drink per day. What's your sobriety worth?*

*Anonymity is kept. The Envelope Chairperson is the only one who knows who is contributing and the amount.*

As Bill W. put it in 1957, "Our spiritual way of life is safe for the future generations if, as a Society, we resist the temptation to receive money from the outside world. But this leaves us with a responsibility---one that every member ought to understand. We cannot skimp when the treasurer of our group passes the hat. Our groups, our areas, and A.A. as a whole will not function unless our services are sufficient and their bills paid.

But when we are generous with the hat we give a token that we are grateful for our blessings and evidence that we are eager to share what we have found with all those who still suffer."


The Education & Participation committee is responsible for fostering and encouraging group participation at the Buffalo Area Intergroup. This is done by providing training to new Intergroup





Motion to accept meeting minutes

### Reports:

**Envelope System:** Pat chair reported took in \$513.00. 37 active members.

**Steering Committee:** Met at 5:30pm on 10/2/2022 had 6 zone reps in attendance nothing new to report

**Financial Report: : September** our Starting Checkbook balance was \$29,207.26. We took in \$5,410.30 (which **up**) in Contributions from Groups and individuals. The Envelope System took in: \$513.00. Literature, Tax & shipping came to \$2,708.42 (which is **up**). 7<sup>th</sup> tradition from committee meeting in office was, \$22.00. Joint Meeting was \$63.00. Total income of **\$9,056.72** (which is **up**).

Our expenses totaled **\$10,374.36** (which is **up**). This means, we took in **\$1,317.64 less** than our expenses this month. **YTD we have taken in \$6,184.12 less than our expenses!!!!** Final checkbook balance is \$30,889.62.

**Corrections** beginning balance was \$4,014.60. Income was \$0.00, A \$3.00 Bank Fee, literature expense of \$185.00 for a balance of \$3,826.60.

**Treatment** beginning balance was \$629.85. Contribution's totaled \$374.50, Expenses were \$368.75 plus a \$3.00 bank fee for a final balance of **\$632.60**.

**7th tradition** collected on 10/2/2022 @ Central Committee meeting \$59.00

The Requirements for each position are as Follows:

- C. **Co-Chairperson**
1. The Co-Chairperson shall be elected by a simple majority vote of Central Committee Representatives or Alternates present and voting at the meeting designated for the election of officers. Candidates for Co-Chairperson shall be Members of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of five (5) years continuous sobriety immediately preceding the date of the election. The Co-Chairperson shall serve for one year (January through December) in that office. Upon conclusion of the Co-Chairperson's year of service, that individual shall automatically succeed to the office of Chairperson in January.
- D. **Recording Secretary**
1. The Recording Secretary shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the Central Committee Representatives present and voting at the meeting designated for the election of officers. Nominees for the office of Recording Secretary shall be Members of Alcoholics Anonymous having a minimum of two (2) years of continuous sobriety immediately preceding the date of the election. The Recording Secretary shall hold office for a one year term (January through December) and shall be eligible for re-nomination and re-election. Nominations for the office of Recording Secretary shall be made annually at the November meeting of the Central Committee. The election for this office shall be held annually at the December meeting and the elected officer shall take office in January.
  2. The Recording Secretary shall have the following duties:
    - take the minutes of all proceedings at meetings of the Central Committee;
    - transcribe the minutes and have them available for review prior to the next Central Committee meeting; and
    - transmit to the Central Committee all resolutions or other communications pertaining to the business of the Central Committee.

**STEERING COMMITTEE**

- Section 3.01 **Purpose and Duties**
- The Steering Committee shall have the duty to advise the Central Committee on all aspects of the management of the property, affairs and business concerns of the Intergroup as well as compliance with all applicable statutes and regulations of the State of New York and in a manner consistent with these By-Laws. Such duties shall include, without limitation, ensuring the Intergroup's compliance with federal, state and local laws, protecting the Intergroup's assets and ensuring the financial viability of the Central Office, allocating the resources in the best interests of the Intergroup such that the Central Committee functions and the Central Office operates in accordance with the Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts of World Service of Alcoholics Anonymous.
- Section 3.02 **Additional Duties**
- A. The Steering Committee shall provide analysis, advice and counsel on matters as requested by the Central Committee Chairperson and/or the Executive Secretary of the Central Office when, because of time and/or other considerations, such matters cannot be brought to the Central Committee.
  - B. The Steering Committee is responsible and authorized to act in place of the Central Committee in emergency situations.
  - C. The Steering Committee shall oversee the whole of Alcoholics Anonymous in the Area and consider whether the actions, policies, the manner of conducting meetings by groups or actions of individual A.A. Members could have an effect on local groups or Alcoholics Anonymous as a whole, as guided by the Twelve Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous.
  - D. The Steering Committee shall follow through on various tasks, matters and/or issues as directed by the Central Committee.
  - E. The Steering Committee shall provide summaries and reports and shall otherwise make suggestions and/or recommendations to the Central Committee.
  - F. The Steering Committee shall serve as the confidential contact and liaison with the Executive Secretary of the Central Office. Such personal and confidential communication will ensure that the Executive Secretary may

air his or her complaints and concerns without fear of reprisal and that the performance of the Executive Secretary may be confidentially evaluated

- B. **Qualifications**  
A Member of the Steering Committee must be a Member of Alcoholics Anonymous whose home group is within the District he or she is elected to represent. The individual must also have at least three (3) years of continuous sobriety before the effective date of his or her term as a Member.
- C. **Term and Election**
3. **District Members** - The term of the Members elected from the 8 Districts shall be two (2) years commencing on January 1<sup>st</sup> following his or her election and ending on December 31<sup>st</sup> of the second year of service.
    - Members representing the following Districts shall be elected to terms beginning in years ending in an **EVEN number**:
 

District 2	North Erie County
District 3	South Buffalo & East
District 7	Buffalo East
District 8	Northeast Erie
    - Members representing the following Districts shall be elected to terms beginning in years ending in an **ODD number**:
 

District 1	Buffalo West
District 4	Southeast
District 5	Niagara County
District 6	Southwest
  4. In the spirit of service rotation, Members may not be re-elected to two (2) consecutive terms on the Steering Committee. However, a Member once having completed and served his or her term may again be nominated and re-elected as a Member after an absence of at least one year from the Steering Committee.
  5. Members of the Steering Committee (from Districts) shall be selected or elected by the Central Committee Members of the groups within the particular Districts in such manner as they shall determine.

Section 4.12 **GSA Liaison**

- A. **Purpose**  
The purpose of the GSA Liaison is to attend meetings between Central Committee and the General Service Area and convey information between the two bodies.
- B. **Term/Election**  
Liaison shall be elected to a 1 year term requirement of 3 years sobriety. May be reelected for 1 more term than rotate.
