For a good portion of my life, I seem to have been plagued with the need to be right. In light of some clearer thinking I see now that it was a simple case whereby my attitude was in need of adjustment and I had been failing to make the adjustment.

The notion that it was my duty to set the world right was egomaniacal. My insistence at having my own way has plagued me for a significant portion of my life. I was very much like the proverbial bull in the china shop when I was determined that I knew what was right for other people.


It was foolish of me to insist I was right all the time. An old saying suggests even a fool is right once in a while. For all I know it may be the other fool's turn to be right and not mine. I do a very healthy thing for myself when I let go of my need to be right.

One secret to gaining contentment is to not contribute to an argument. An amazing thing happens when I decide not to contribute to it – the argument gets shorter. Every human being I encounter has as much right as I have to be on this planet and every blessed one of us has the right to sometimes be wrong.

I must confess that my need to be right seems to have been inversely proportional to my age. The old timer who is writing this has mellowed quite a bit as of late (although my wife may very well disagree). At this time of my life I can sense when a discussion is getting heated and right smack in the middle of it I can pause long enough to think, "How important is this?" It is much easier on my system to simply curb this damnable need to be right.

It must have been a sage who suggested that we must not take ourselves too seriously. I don't have to live up to any-one's expectations, not even my own. Before dropping off to sleep at night I sometimes remember to think, "I forgive anyone and everyone who has ever harmed me at any time, in any manner, under any circumstances, in this lifetime or in any other." This improves my sleep pattern. A philosophical question seems to be: "Would you rather be right or happy?" Ideally I might answer, "*Let others be right; if I forgive I sleep better.*" I do not always put this into practice, however.



## Treatment Facilities Committee

Each group has but one primary purpose - to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.\*

### Featured Committee of the Month Treatment Committee

The *Treatment Committee* is this month's featured committee. Please take a moment to read some information that the committee would like for you to know about:



1. *What Treatment's purpose is.*
2. *How it helps the alcoholic who still suffers.*
3. *How you can grow spiritually by being involved.*
4. *How you and your group can get involved.*

#### 1. Purpose of Committee:

To bring AA meetings into treatment facilities in the Buffalo/ Niagara area, where we share our experience, strength and hope to the still sick and suffering alcoholics and introduce AA as a solution to the recovery process. This happens by:

1. **Assigning meetings of a specific facility** at a set time to individual home groups on a monthly basis that can be men's, women's or mixed meeting. Your group **Treatment Rep. service positions** is given the task to get support from your home group to attend the facility meeting.

#### 2. How It Helps The Alcoholic Who Still Suffers:

The *Treatment Committee* helps many Alcoholics in the treatment setting who may or may not know about a solution of recovery. In these facilities we are able to share our experiences, to help encourage the still sick and suffering who may feel like there is no hope.

We share what it was like, what happened and what it is like now along with the solution being our experience of working a program of action designed in the book of Alcoholics Anonymous. We may be the first contact a patient in a treatment facility may have of someone just like them who is sober and walks a free man.

#### 3. How You Can Grow Spiritually By Getting Involved:

Getting involved with the *Treatment Committee* provides individuals with the opportunity to help others with the rewards that are far greater than anything we can possibly share with them.

The biggest gift is seeing a treatment patient walk through the door of an AA meeting once they have been discharged. The feeling is like no other. ALWAYS, or primary purpose is to carry the message to the still sick and suffering Alcoholic. In doing this we experience the gift of giving back what has so freely been given to us.

#### 4. How You and Your Group Can Get Involved (time of committee, jobs to do at the committee):

The way to get involved with the *Treatment Committee* is to come to the St. Andrews School Hall, 111 Crocker & Reiman, Sloan on the 1st Sunday of the Month at 5:30 PM. Come join us and see if the committee is right for you.



## Central Committee Minutes April 6th, 2025



The meeting opened at 7:00pm by Vice Chairperson Joe with a moment of silence followed by the Responsibility Declaration and the Closing Our Father. Volunteers read as follows: Preamble by Diane, The Purpose of Central Committee by Kirste, and the Twelve Traditions by Tony. Andy presented the Fourth Tradition. Mary will present the Fifth Tradition in May. A motion to accept the Mar2025 meeting minutes was made and accepted.

### Reports

**Envelope System:** Terry reported. \$603 was brought in.

**Steering Committee:** Dan reported. Approved Convention Contract.

**Financial Report Nick presented. This is the Reconciled report**

**April 2025:** our Starting Checkbook balance was \$49,751.05. We took in \$ 6,747.00 (which is **up**) in Contributions from Groups and individuals. The Envelope System took in: \$603.00. Literature, Tax & shipping came to \$2,007.75 (which is **down**) New Frontiers Subscriptions was \$66.00. Joint meeting (Central Committee) was \$74.00. Our Total income of **\$9,567.75** (which is **about the same as last month**).

Our expenses totaled **\$11,031.62** (which up due to annual sales tax payment.). This means, we spent **\$1,463.87 more** than our income this month. **YTD we are down \$613.63 less than our current expenses for 2025 (much better than this time in years past).** Final checkbook balance is \$48,287.18.

~~~ Note Next month we will be paying our annual Accountant for our 2024 taxes.

**Corrections** beginning balance was \$253.60.. Income= \$204.00. Expenses: \$none and a \$3.00 Bank Fee, for a balance of \$630.60.

**Treatment** beginning balance was 815.66. Contribution's totaled \$204.00. Expenses: \$none plus a \$3.00 bank fee, for a final balance of \$1,016.66.

**Treatment Facilities:** Laurel reported. Twenty-three people attended. Renewed all commitments which include Casa di Vita, Stutzman, ECMC, 291 Elm (Terrace House), Salvation Army, Buffalo Psych Center, and Veterans Hospital. Treatment and Facility committee has resigned as coordinator to St. Joe's, Clearview this past month. There have been several individuals who have brought AA meetings to St. Joe's since it opened (right after pandemic). They had asked for our help filling meeting times but now have decided they are taking over completely. So as not to be confrontational, we backed out and remain available in the future if "the hand reaches out" for us to begin again. We have been using All App downloaded on our phones for communication (the "Group Me" app) between Treatment & Facilities members to connect, for instance when a commitment cannot be met, it is working well. Still presenting Bridging the Gap program to facility patients as a connection to AA when they leave treatment. We are making a flyer to promote/encourage folks to come check out T&F, get involved and bring information about T&F to their home groups and other meetings.

**Corrections:** Diane reported. The prison strike has ended, and all scheduled meetings have resumed. Currently, Diane has not heard of any closed facilities. Tony M. reported that AA literature is returned when a facility is closed. Volunteers are needed for the Erie County Holding Center. It meets on Mondays at 7pm (6:30 arrival time). **Night Watch:** Stephanie reported. We had one presentation at Straight Pepper Diet this month; they took the July commitment. Currently, our next opening is in September. **Internet Presence:** No report/not present..


**PIC/CPC:** Open position with chairperson needed.
